O.M.F.C. SCALE AEROBATICS CONTEST - 24TH AUG, 2002

Bert Armstrong has agreed to C.D. , a Scale Aerobatics Competition at our South Field on Saturday the 24th of August 2002. This contest will fly two classes, "Novice" & "Sportsman". The following maneuvers will make up the Novice class.

Take Off, Straight Flight Out, Procedure Turn, Straight Flight Back, One Loop, Stall Turn or Immelman, One Roll, & Landing. (See Precision Aerobatics Sportsman Schedule.)

The following maneuvers will make up the "Sportsman" Class,

Take Off, One Inside Loop, Pull / Push / Pull Humpty Bump with 1/2 Roll Down, Stall Turn, One Roll, Sharks Tooth with a 1/2 Roll on the 45 deg, down line, Vertical Up Line, Split Ess Turn, 1/2 Cuban Eight, Landing. (See IMAC Basic Sequence)
